- Economy contracted by 8.4 percent in Q₂ 2022.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil and WTI decreased by USD 1.89 and USD 0.35 bbl respectively.
- CCPI decreased to 66.0 percent (YoY) in October, 2022 from 69.8 percent (YoY) in September, 2022
- NCPI increased to 73.7 percent (YoY) in September from 70.2 percent (YoY) in August, 2022

- Exchange Rate depreciate to USD 1=Rs.366.29 from USD 1=Rs. 365.93

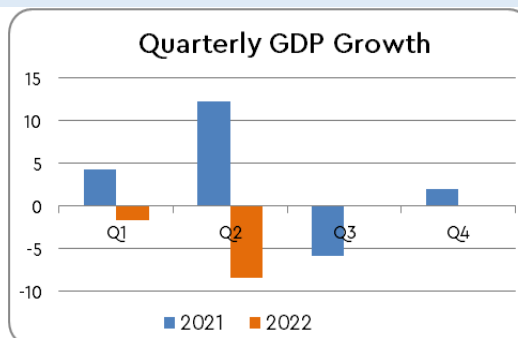

GDP contracted by 8.4 % in Q₂ 2022

In the Q₂ of 2022, the GDP growth rate contracted by 8.4 compared to the 12.3 percent increase reported in the Q₂ of 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the 8.4 percent, 10.0 percent and 2.2 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector respectively.

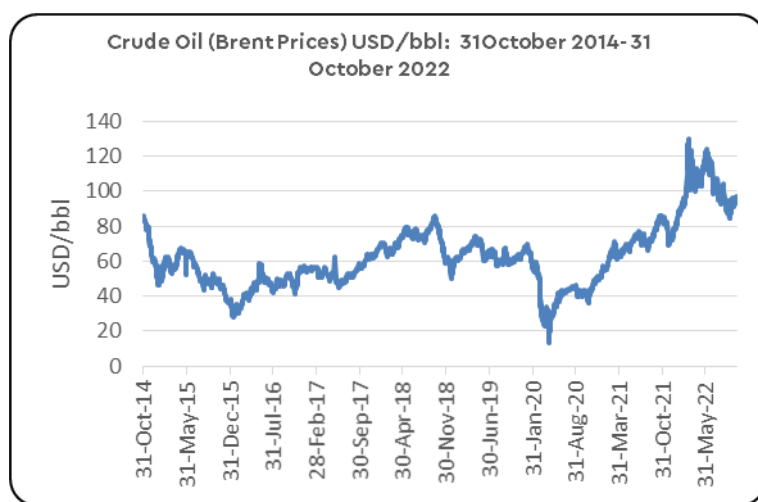
