- Economy contracted by 1.6 percent in Q₁ 2022.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil decreased by USD 3.09 to USD 118.96 per bbl as at 17 June, 2022 from USD 122.05 per bbl as at 10 June, 2022
- CCPI increased to 54.1 percent (YoY) in June, 2022 from 39.1 percent (YoY) in May, 2022
- NCPI increased to 45.3 percent (YoY) in May from 33.8 percent (YoY) in April, 2022

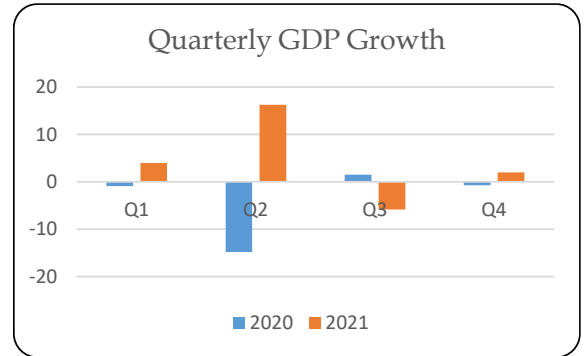

GDP contracted by 1.6 % in Q₁ 2022

In the Q₁ of 2022, recorded a decline of 1.6 percent in the GDP growth rate against the 4.0 percent incline reported in the Q₁ of 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the 6.8 percent and 4.7 considerable decline in the agriculture and industry sector, respectively compared to the 6.4 percent and 6.0 percent expansion recorded in Q₁ of 2021. Further, the overall services sector exhibited a 0.7 percent trivial expansion in Q₁ of 2022 compared to 3.5 percent of Q₁ of 2021.

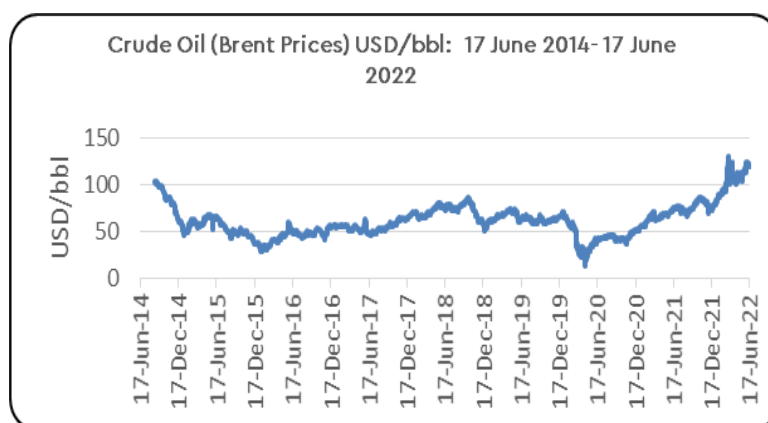
