Implementation of Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) System in Sri Lanka

Your kind attention is drawn to the Public Finance Circular No.08/2019(i) dated 19.04.2023 and Public Finance Circular No.08/2019 dated 17.12.2019 on "Implementation of Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) System in Sri Lanka".

2. Accordingly, Procuring Entities (PEs) and Liaison Officers (LOs) have been requested to register in the e-GP system and request the suppliers who have register in the Annual Supplier List of PEs to register in the e-GP System, publish procurement notices of all procurements planned to be conducted and publish award details of all procurements in the Government e-Procurement platform (www.promise.lk).

3. Meantime, the Department of Public Finance has completed the development of e-GP System Version 2.1 enabling the e-Procurements under shopping method of Goods category in a more advanced manner. The implementation of the e-GP System for other procurement methods, including National Competitive Bidding (NCB) and International Competitive Bidding (ICB) will be carried out during the year 2024 in a phased out manner as per the e-GP Roll-out Plan.

4. Essential information on how the e-GP System can be utilized by the PEs, LOs and vendors is accessible through User Guides and User Videos on the promise.lk website. Additionally, hands-on training sessions will be provided to the Liaison Officers of Procuring Entities to ensure they are well-versed in conducting e-Procurements using the system.

5. Accordingly, all the PEs are requested to adopt following measures in the process of e-GP system application.

5.1. Undertaking of Procurement through e-GP platform

All the PEs are requested to use e-GP platform to undertake the Goods procurements under shopping method whenever possible. If the PE requires any assistance to conduct e-Procurement, you may please email promise@pfd.treasury.gov.lk the titles of the selected procurements you wish to initiate through the e-GP System with names and contact numbers of relevant liaison

officers who wish to conduct them. The e-GP Secretariat will contact the relevant liaison officers and provide necessary support.

5.2. Information on Contract of Awarding

With the releasing of e-GP system version 2.1, a new feature has been introduced to facilitate the transparent disclosure of contract awards by the respective PEs. Accordingly, it is mandated for the PEs to publish details as given in the promise.lk website within 3 days from the date of the each contract award.
