- Economy contracted by 8.4 percent in Q₂ 2022.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil decreased by USD 3.5 to USD per 87.61 bbl as at 30 September, 2022 from USD 91.11 per bbl as at 16 September, 2022
- CCPI increased to 69.8 percent (YoY) in September, 2022 from 64.3 percent (YoY) in August, 2022
- NCPI increased to 70.2 percent (YoY) in August from 66.7 percent (YoY) in July, 2022

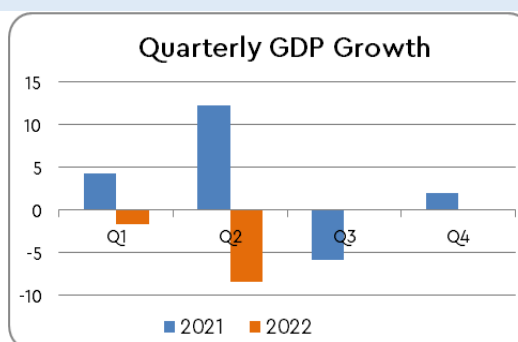

In the Q₂ of 2022, the GDP growth rate contracted by 8.4 compared to the 12.3 percent increase reported in the Q₂ of 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the 8.4 percent, 10.0 percent and 2.2 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector respectively.

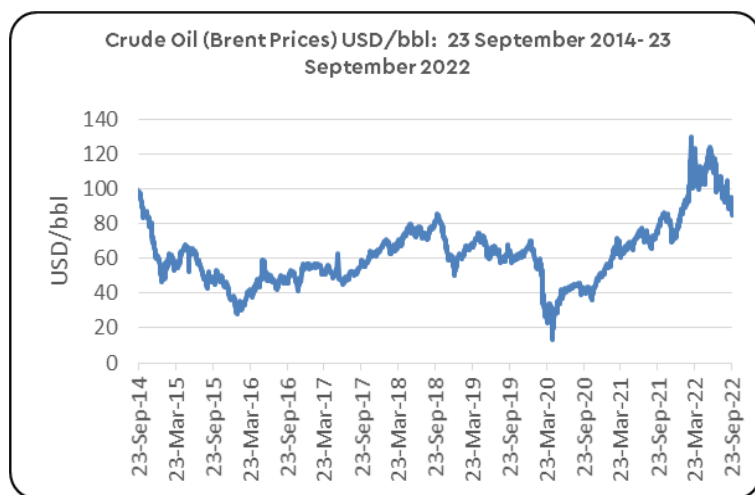
