The Week in Review  
30<sup>th</sup> March – 03<sup>rd</sup> April 2026

### REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.0 percent in 2025.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 0.4 USD bbl and WTI increased by 11.52 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 2.2 percent (YoY) in March, 2026 from 1.6 percent (YoY) in February, 2026.
- NCPI – Headline inflation (2021=100) decreased to 1.6 percent (YoY) in February, 2026 from 2.4 percent (YoY) in January, 2025.

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### EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly depreciated to USD 1=Rs. 315.53 from USD 1=Rs. 314.42
- Exports decreased to USD 1,057.8 mn in February 2026 compared to USD 1,148.7 mn in January 2026.
- Imports increased to USD 1,833.8 mn in February 2026 compared to USD 1,803.3 mn in January 2026.
- Trade deficit
  - USD 776.1 mn in February, 2026
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 7.3 bn as end of February 2026.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 729.0 mn in February 2026.

- Credit to the private sector increased by 26.4 percent (YoY) in February, 2026

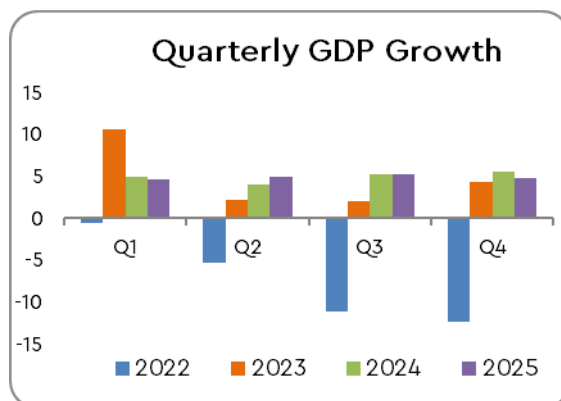

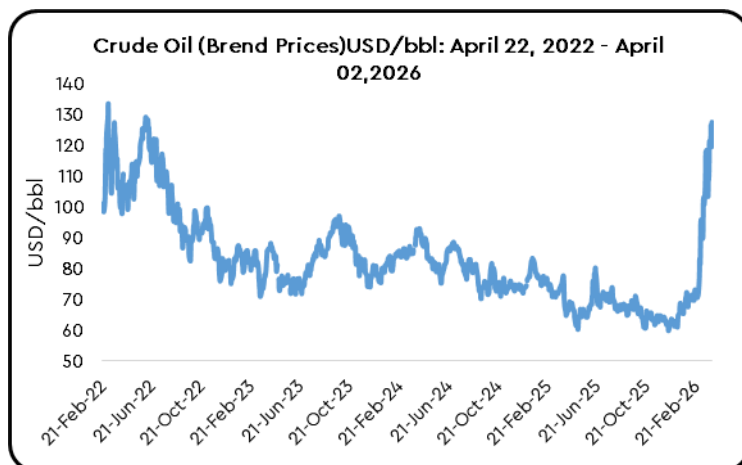
