The Week in Review
24 June – 28 June 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.3 percent in the 1st quarter 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 1.62 USD bbl and WTI increased by 0.73 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) declined to 0.9 percent (YoY) in May, 2024 from 1.5 percent (YoY) in April, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) declined to 1.6 percent (YoY) in May, 2024 from 2.7 percent (YoY) in April, 2024

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee has slightly depreciated to USD 1=Rs. 305.69 from USD 1=Rs. 305.35
- Exports declined to USD 0.878 bn in April 2024 compared to USD 1.139 bn in March 2024
- Imports declined to USD 1.435 bn in April 2024 compared to USD 1.508 bn in March 2024
- Trade deficit
 - USD 557.7 mn in April, 2024
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 5.4 bn as end of May 2024.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 544.4 mn in May, 2024.

GDP expanded by 5.3 % in 1st Quarter 2024

In the first quarter of 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.3 percent, a notable improvement from the 10.7 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2023. This expansion was observed across all economic sectors recording a 1.1 percent, 11.8 percent, and 2.6 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

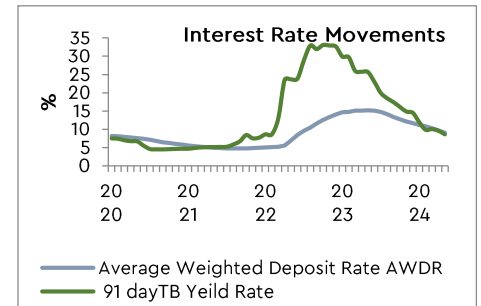

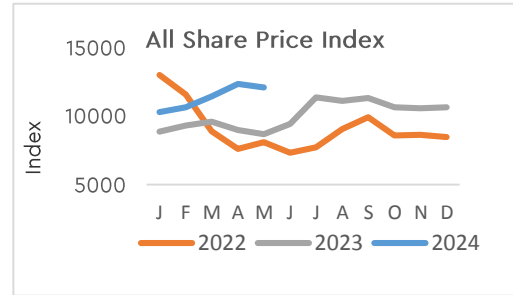
