

### GDP contracted by 11.8 % in $Q_3 2022$

In the  $Q_3$  of 2022, the GDP growth rate contracted by 11.8 compared to the 5.8 contraction reported in the  $Q_3$  of 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the 8.7 percent, 21.2 percent and 2.6 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector respectively.


