The Week in Review
24th November – 28th November 2025

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.9 percent in the second quarter of 2025.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 0.61 USD bbl and WTI increased by 0.64 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 2.1 percent (YoY) in October, 2025 from 1.5 percent (YoY) in September, 2025.
- NCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 2.7 percent (YoY) in October, 2025 from 2.1 percent (YoY) in September, 2025.

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 308.03 from USD 1=Rs. 308.05
- Exports increased to USD 1,149.4 mn in October 2025 compared to USD 1,138.5 mn in September 2025.
- Imports increased to USD 2,156.8 mn in October 2025 compared to USD 2,048.6 mn in September 2025.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 1,007.4 mn in October, 2025
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.2 bn as end of October 2025.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 712.0 mn in October 2025.

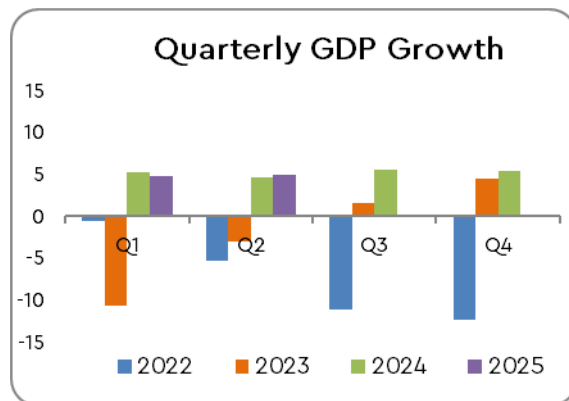

GDP expanded by 4.9 % in 2nd quarter 2025

In the second quarter of 2025, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 4.9 percent, compared to 4.1 percent growth recorded in the same period of 2024. This expansion was observed recording a 2.0 percent, 5.8 percent and 3.9 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.

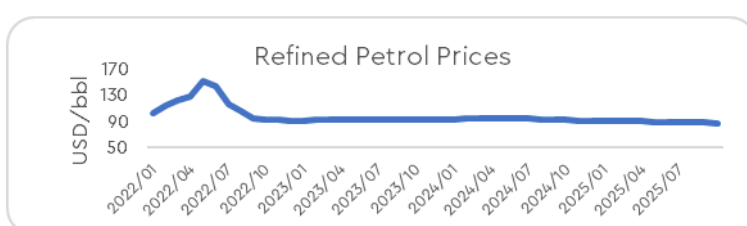
