

# GDP contracted by 8.4 % in $Q_2$ 2022

In the  $Q_2$  of 2022, the GDP growth rate contracted by 8.4 compared to the 12.3 percent increase reported in the  $Q_2$  of 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the 8.4 percent, 10.0 percent and 2.2 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector respectively.
