To: All Secretaries to the Ministries and the Chairmen and the Public Corporations, Statutory Boards & Fully Owner Government Companies.

Restructure of Salaries of the Employees in the Public Corporations, Statutory Boards & fully owner Government Companies as per Management Services Circular No.30 - stagnation in the maximum

It is hereby informed to act as follows in respect of the employees in the public Cooperation's, Statutory Boards & full-owned government companies, stagnating in the maximum of the salary scale where the salary scheme introduced by the management services Circular No. 30 operates in line with the P.A. Circular No. 6/2006 (iii) dated 25/01/2007 detailing the procedure to be followed related to awarding of increments for public officers stagnating in the maximum of the salary scale.

- 02. The officers reaching the maximum of the new salary scale approved under Management services Circular No. 30 may be paid the increments on the value of the last drawn increment until such officer retires or appointed/promoted to a new post with another salary scale.
- 03. This benefit is entitle only to the officers who reach the maximum having qualified to promotion from grade by grade of a certain salary scale. This benefit is not entitle to the officers who have not obtained a promotion in the lower grade in the salary scale. The maximum step in respect of a salary scale with a grade system of recruitment and promotion should be treated as the maximum salary scale applicable to the highest grade of the relevant salary scale. e.g. the maximum salary step of PL in the salary step of Rs.16,820/-
- 04. The payments from 01.01.2006 to 31.12.2006 is limited to 50% of the salary receivable as at 01.01.2006.
- 05. This circular is issued on the recommendation of the National Salaries & Cadre Commission.
- 06. The Treasury will not provide additional provisions to implement this circular and be managed with the current financial provisions.
