The Week in Review
25 March – 28 March 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy contracted by 2.3 percent in 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 3.72 USD bbl and WTI declined by 0.79 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) declined to 0.9 percent (YoY) in March, 2024 from 5.9 percent (YoY) in February, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) increased to 5.1 percent (YoY) in February, 2024 from 6.5 percent (YoY) in January, 2024

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee appreciated to USD 1=Rs.300.44 from USD 1=Rs. 303.84
- Exports increased to USD 1.059 bn in February 2024 compared to USD 0.971 bn in January 2024
- Imports declined to USD 1.378 bn in February 2024 compared to USD 1.512 bn in January 2024
- Trade deficit
 - USD 319 mn in February, 2024
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 4.5 bn as end of February 2024.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 476.2 mn in February, 2024.

GDP contracted by 2.3 % in 2023

In 2023, the Sri Lankan economy contracted by 2.3 percent compared to the 7.3 percent contraction in 2022. This downturn was reflected in industry and Services sectors, which contracted by 9.2 percent and 0.2 percent, respectively. Conversely, the Agriculture Sector exhibited a growth, expanding by 2.6 percent.

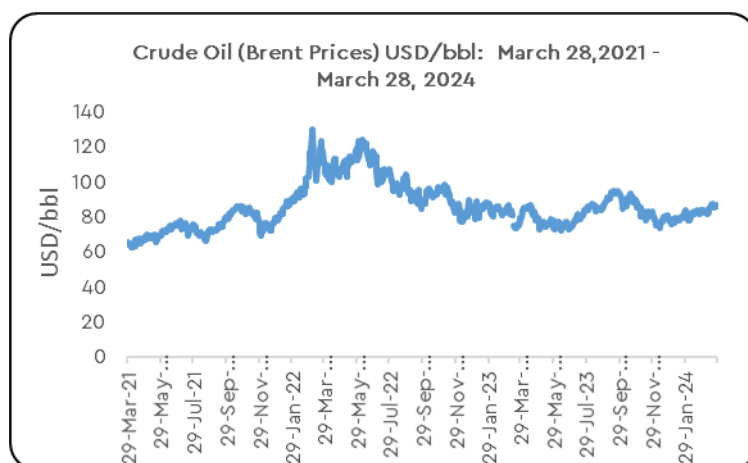

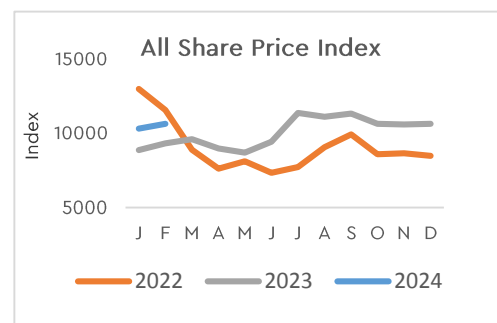
