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

### GDP expanded by 3.7 % in 2021

The Sri Lankan economy expanded by 3.7 percent in 2021 compared to the -3.6 percent in 2020. The expansion was mainly driven by positive growth rates of 2.0 percent 5.3 and 3.0 percent in the agriculture, Industry and Services sectors, respectively compared to the negetive growth of -2.2 percent, -6.9 percent recorded in the 2020.
