07th April – 11th April 2025

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.0 percent in 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 6.78 USD bbl and WTI declined by 7.17 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to -2.6 percent (YoY) in March, 2025 from -4.2 percent (YoY) in February, 2025.
- NCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to -3.9 percent (YoY) in February, 2025 from -4.0 percent (YoY) in January, 2025. [More on this on page 2](#)

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly depreciated to USD 1=Rs. 298.71 from USD 1=Rs. 296.83
- Exports very marginally increased to USD 1,052.9 mn in February 2025 compared to USD 1,052.8 mn in January 2025.
- Imports declined to USD 1,464.2 mn in February 2025 compared to USD 1,785.5 mn in January 2025.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 411.3 mn in February, 2025
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.5 bn as end of March 2025.

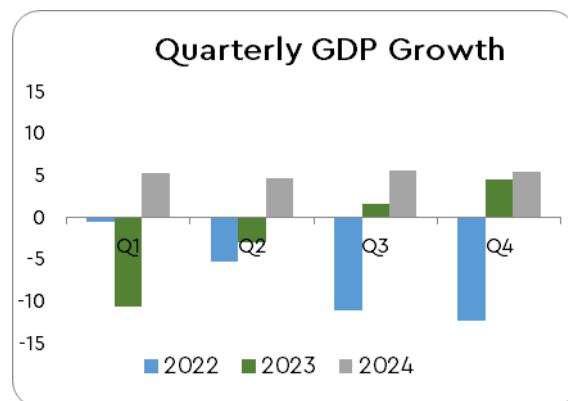

GDP expanded by 5.0 % in 2024

In 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.0 percent, a notable improvement from the 2.3 percent contraction recorded in the year 2023. This expansion was observed across all the sectors of the economy recording a 1.2 percent, 11.0 percent and 2.4 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.
