06 November – 10 November 2023

### REAL SECTOR

- Economy contracted by 3.1 percent in second quarter 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil and WTI declined by 6.74 & 6.91 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI (2021=100) increased to 1.5 percent (YoY) in October, 2023 from 1.3 percent (YoY) in September, 2023
- NCPI (YoY%) (2021=100) declined to 0.8 percent (YoY) in September, 2023 from 2.1 percent (YoY) in August, 2023

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### EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee appreciated to USD 1=Rs.327.59 from USD 1=Rs. 328.90
- Exports declined to USD 0.97 bn in September 2023 compared to USD 1.12 bn in August 2023
- Imports declined to USD 1.35 bn in September 2023 compared to USD 1.43 bn in August 2023
- Trade deficit

- The gross official reserves stood at USD 3.6 bn as end of October

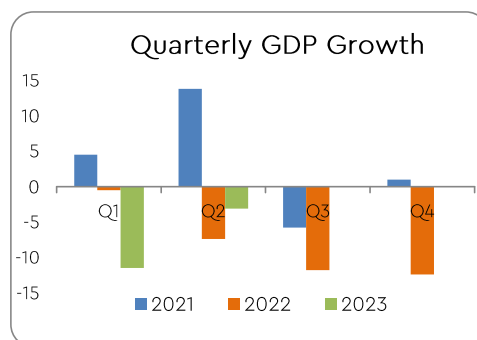

### GDP contracted by 3.1 % in the Q<sub>2</sub> of 2023

In the second quarter of 2023, the economy contracted by 3.1 compared to the 7.4 percent contraction in the same period of 2022. This contraction has mainly led by the 11.5 contraction in the industrial sector owing to the contraction in construction and manufacturing sectors and -0.8 contraction of the service sector due to large contraction in financial services, insurance and real estate. The contraction in the service sector partially offset by growth in transportation and accommodation, food & beverage services. However, agriculture sector grew by 3.6 percent in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters of 2023 benefiting from availability of fertilizer and sound weather conditions.

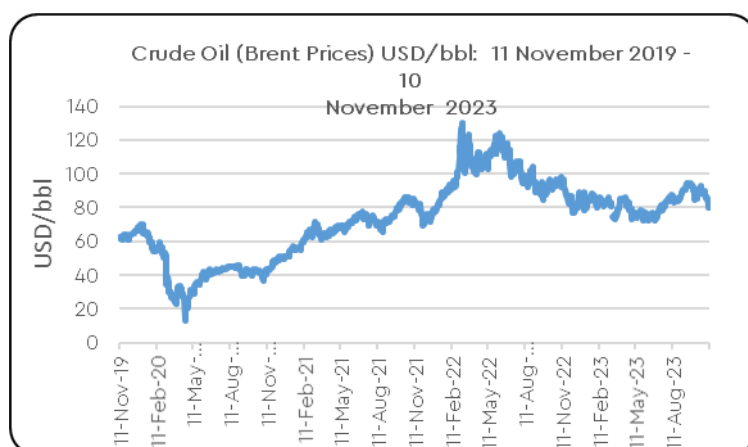

- Export earnings declined by 13.1 percent to USD 971.7 mn in September 2023 compared to August 2023.
- Import expenditure declined by 5.4 percent to USD 1,349.3 mn in September 2023 compared to August 2023.
- Trade deficit widened to USD 378 mn in September 2023.

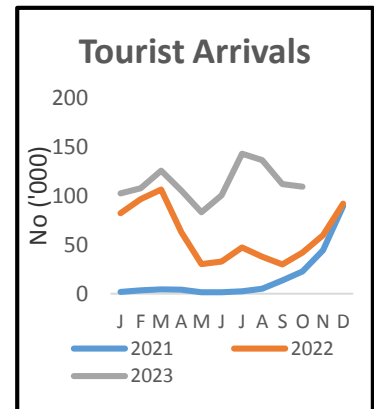

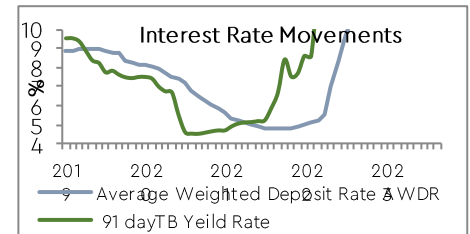

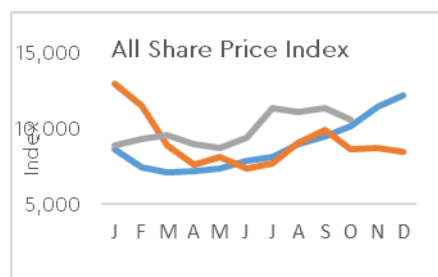
