29 April – 03 May 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy contracted by 2.3 percent in 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 5.43 USD bbl and WTI declined by 4.68 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) increased to 1.5 percent (YoY) in, April 2024 from 0.9 percent (YoY) in March, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) increased to 2.7 percent (YoY) in April, 2024 from 2.5 percent (YoY) in March, 2024

GDP contracted by 2.3 % in 2023

In 2023, the Sri Lankan economy contracted by 2.3 percent compared to the 7.3 percent contraction in 2022. This downturn was reflected in industry and Services sectors, which contracted by 9.2 percent and 0.2 percent, respectively. Conversely, the Agriculture Sector exhibited a growth, expanding by 2.6 percent.

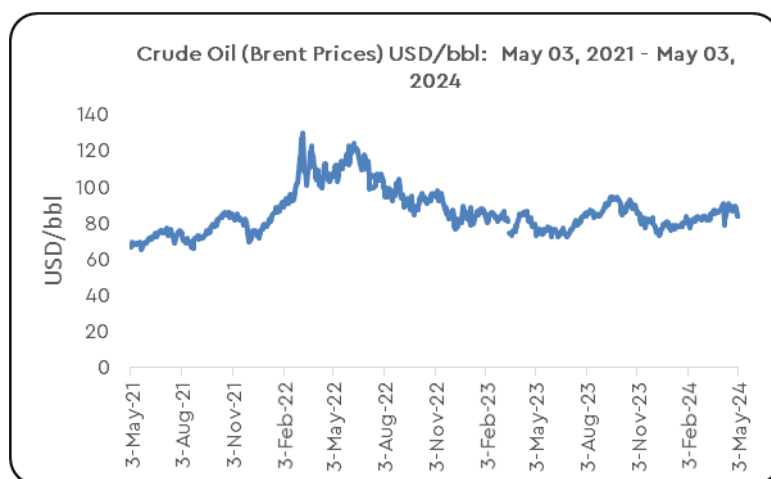

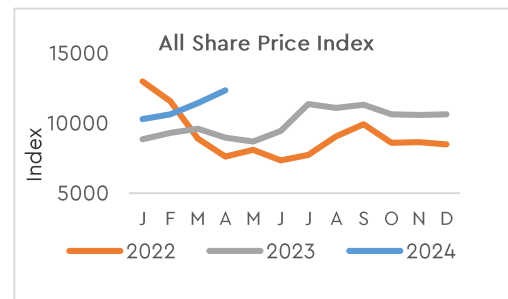
