### REAL SECTOR

- Economy contracted by 11.5 percent in first quarter 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil and WTI decreased by 1.55 & 1.45 USD bbl respectively.
- CCPI (2021=100) decreased to 12.0 percent (YoY) in June, 2023 from 25.2 percent (YoY) in May, 2023
- NCPI (YoY%) (2021=100) decreased to 22.1 percent (YoY) in May 2023 from 33.6 percent (YoY) in April 2023

- Exchange Rate depreciate to USD 1=Rs.308.92 from USD 1=Rs.306.70
- Exports increased to USD 1.02 bn in May 2023 compared to USD 0.85 bn in April 2023

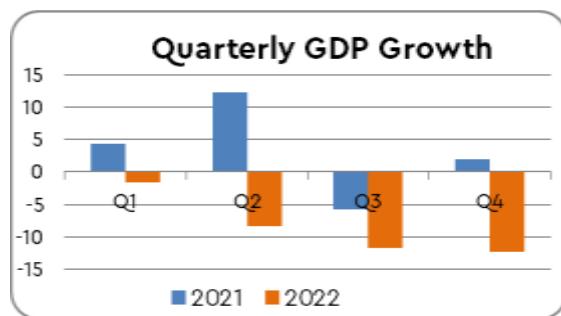

### GDP contracted by -11.5 % in 2023

In 2023, the GDP growth rate contracted by -11.5 compared to the -0.5 reported in 2022. This contraction was mainly due to the 0.8 percent, -23.4 percent and -5.0 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.

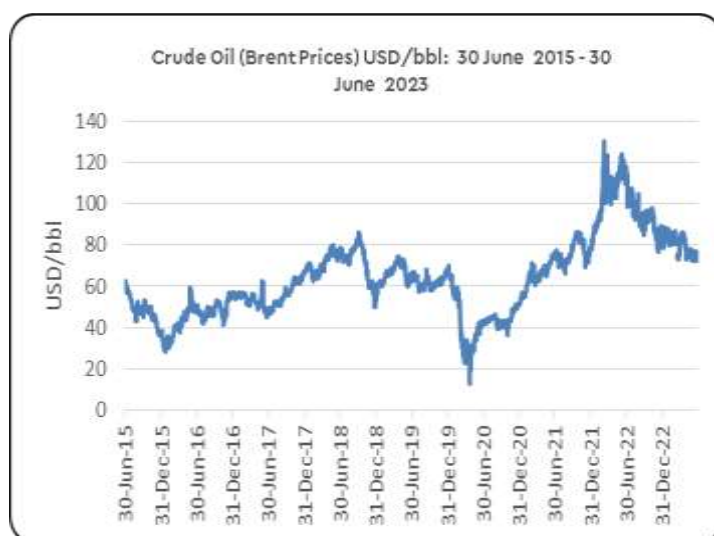
