Submission of Annual Reports and Accounts to Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Monitoring Board (SLAASMB)

It has been brought to my notice by the SLAASMB that several Corporations have so far not submitted the Annual Reports and Accounts for the financial years 2000, 2001 and 2002 to the SLAASMB.

In terms of Section 25 (1) of the Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Act No. 15 of 1995 every specified business enterprise which is a Public Corporation or a Board engaged in the sale of goods or provision of services, should submit its audited financial statements to the Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Monitoring Board.

You are therefore requested to submit two copies of each of the Annual Reports along with the audited financial statements for the years 2000,2001,2002 and 2003.
