The Week in Review
23th June – 27th June 2025

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.8 percent in the first quarter of 2025.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil decreased by 8.96 USD bbl and WTI decreased by 10.31 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to -0.6 percent (YoY) in June, 2025 from -0.7 percent (YoY) in May, 2025.
- NCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 0.6 percent (YoY) in May, 2025 from -0.8 percent (YoY) in April, 2025.

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 300.02 from USD 1=Rs. 300.75
- Exports increased to USD 1,034.7 mn in May 2025 compared to USD 968.4 mn in April 2025.
- Imports decreased to USD 1,507.2 mn in May 2025 compared to USD 1,685.9 mn in April 2025.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 472.5 mn in May, 2025
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.3 bn as end of April 2025.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 641.7 mn in May 2025.

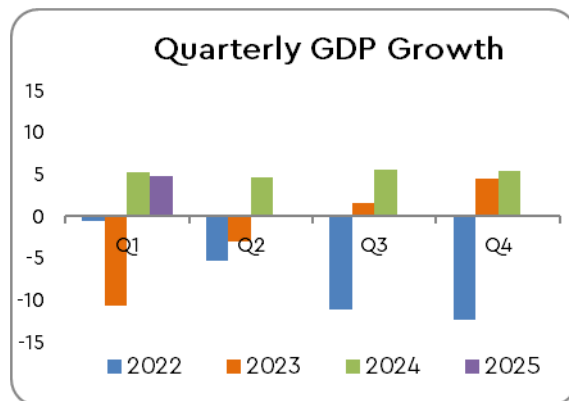

GDP expanded by 4.8 % in 1st quarter 2024

In the first quarter of 2025, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 4.8 percent, compared to 5.1 percent growth recorded in the same period of 2024. This expansion was observed recording a 9.7 percent and 2.8 percent growth in the industry and service sector, respectively. Agriculture sector contracted by 0.7 percent.

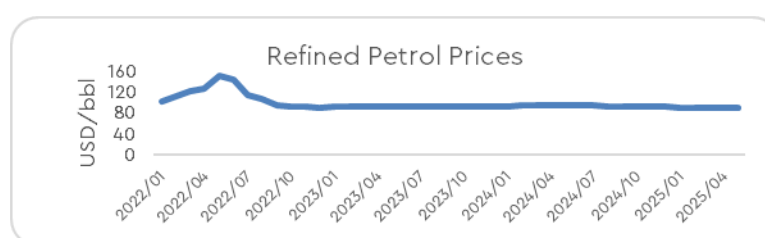

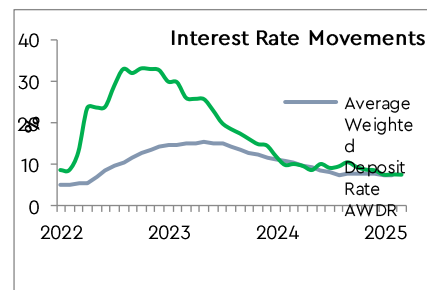
