- Economy contracted by 11.5 percent in first quarter 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil and WTI increased by 1.6 & 2.13 USD bbl respectively.
- CCPI (2021=100) decreased to 6.3 percent (YoY) in July, 2023 from 12.0 percent (YoY) in June, 2023
- NCPI (YoY%) (2021=100) decreased to 10.8 percent (YoY) in June, 2023 from 22.1 percent (YoY) in May, 2023

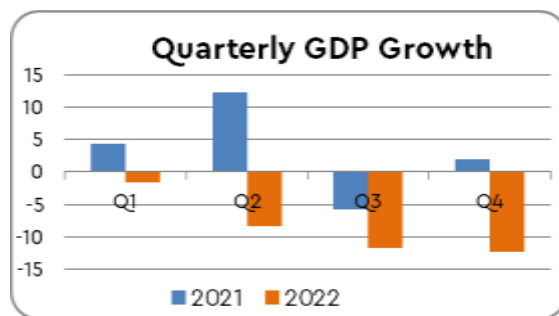

GDP contracted by -11.5 % in 2023

In 2023, the GDP growth rate contracted by -11.5 compared to the -0.5 reported in 2022. This contraction was mainly due to the 0.8 percent, -23.4 percent and -5.0 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.

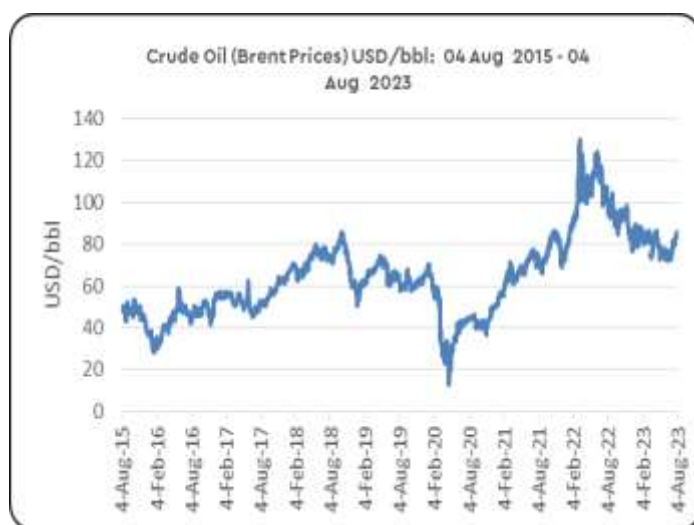
