The Week in Review
07th October – 11th October 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.7 percent in the 2nd quarter 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 6.46 USD bbl and WTI increased by 6.48 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) declined to -0.5 percent (YoY) in September, 2024 from 0.5 percent (YoY) in August, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) declined to 1.1 percent (YoY) in August, 2024 from 2.5 percent (YoY) in July, 2024

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 292.96 from USD 1=Rs. 294.00
- Exports increased to USD 1.22 bn in August 2024 compared to USD 1.13 bn in July 2024
- Imports declined to USD 1.65 bn in August 2024 compared to USD 1.73 bn in July 2024
- Trade deficit

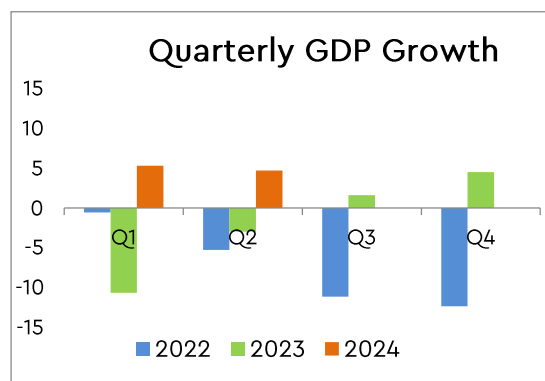

GDP expanded by 4.7 % in 2nd Quarter 2024

In the second quarter of 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 4.7 percent, a notable improvement from the -3.0 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2023. This expansion was observed across all economic sectors recording a 1.7 percent, 10.9 percent, and 2.5 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

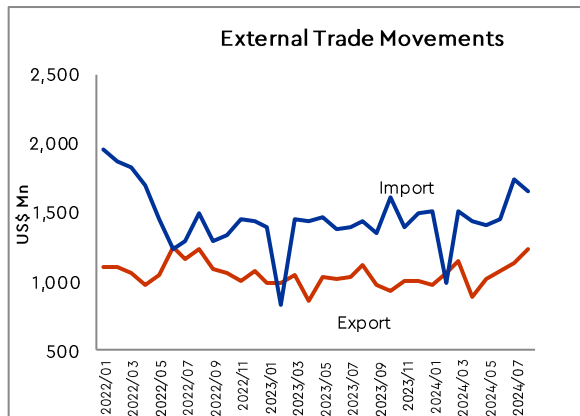

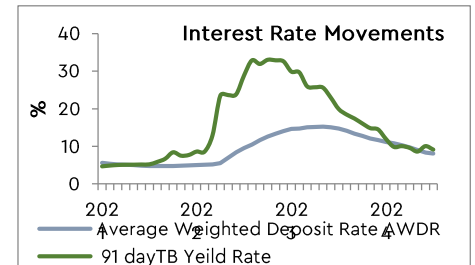

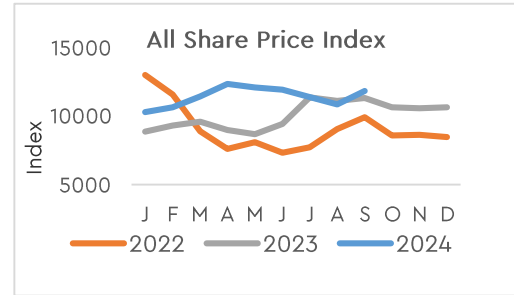
