The Week in Review
15th June – 19th June 2026

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.1 percent in the first quarter 2026.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil fell by 9.86 USD bbl and WTI declined by 10.71 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 5.5 percent (YoY) in May, 2026 from 5.4 percent (YoY) in April, 2026.
- NCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 5.4 percent (YoY) in May, 2026 from 4.7 percent (YoY) in April, 2026

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- The Sri Lankan rupee marginally appreciated to USD 1 = Rs. 333.78 from USD 1 = Rs. 336.39
- Exports decreased to USD 1,074.1 mn in April 2026 compared to USD 1,254.3 mn in March 2026.
- Imports increased to USD 2,456.7 mn in April 2026 compared to USD 2,134.1 mn in March 2026.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 1,382.6 mn in April, 2026
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.8 bn as end of April 2026.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 847.0 mn in May 2026.

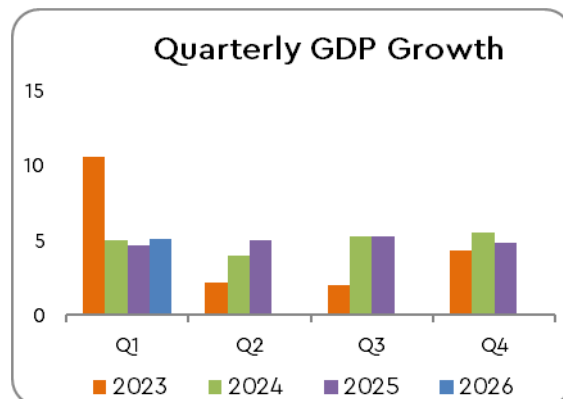

In the first quarter of 2026, In the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.1 percent compared to 4.7 percent growth recorded in the same period of 2025. This expansion was observed recording 1.1 percent, 7.2 percent and 3.4 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.
