- Economy contracted by 7.8 percent in 2022.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil and WTI increased by 0.31 USD and 0.03 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI (2021=100) decreased to 25.2 percent (YoY) in May, 2023 from 35.3 percent (YoY) in April, 2023
- NCPI (YoY%) (2021=100) decreased to 33.6 percent (YoY) in April 2023 from 49.2 percent (YoY) in March 2023

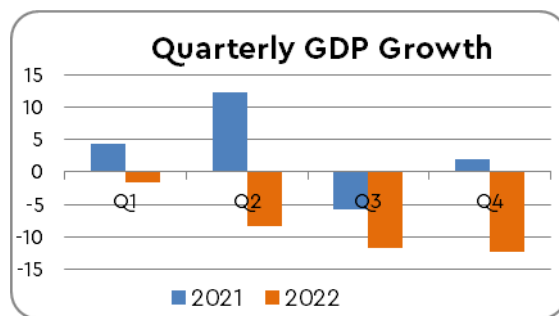

GDP contracted by -7.8 % in 2022

In 2022, the GDP growth rate contracted by 7.8 compared to the 3.5 growth reported in 2021. This contraction was mainly due to the -4.6 percent, -16.0 percent and -2.0 percent considerable decline in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.

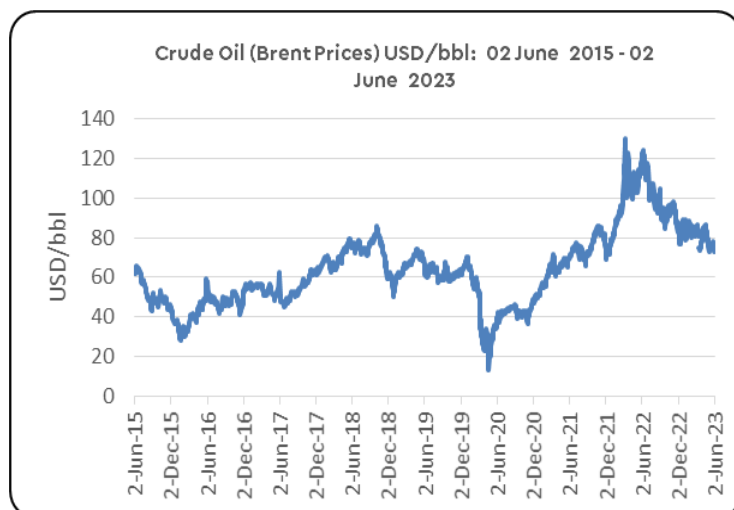
