The Week in Review
05th May – 09th May 2025

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.0 percent in 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 0.38 USD bbl and WTI increased by 0.3 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to -2.0 percent (YoY) in April, 2025 from -2.6 percent (YoY) in March, 2025.
- NCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to -1.9 percent (YoY) in March, 2025 from -3.9 percent (YoY) in February, 2025.

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 299.06 from USD 1=Rs. 299.44
- Exports increased to USD 1,241.7 mn in March 2025 compared to USD 1,052.9 mn in February 2025.
- Imports increased to USD 1,637.3 mn in March 2025 compared to USD 1,464.2 mn in February 2025.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 395.6 mn in March, 2025
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.5 bn as end of March 2025.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 646.1 mn in April 2025.

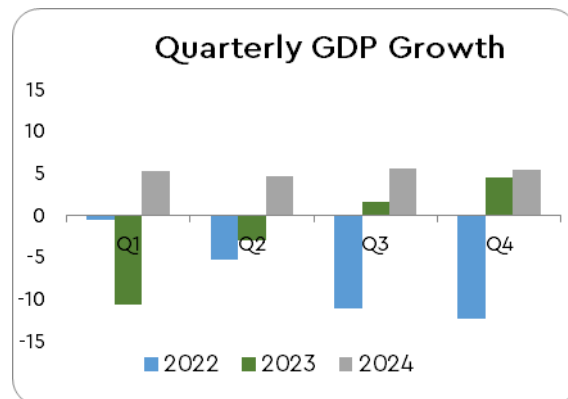

GDP expanded by 5.0 % in 2024

In 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.0 percent, a notable improvement from the 2.3 percent contraction recorded in the year 2023. This expansion was observed across all the sectors of the economy recording a 1.2 percent, 11.0 percent and 2.4 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

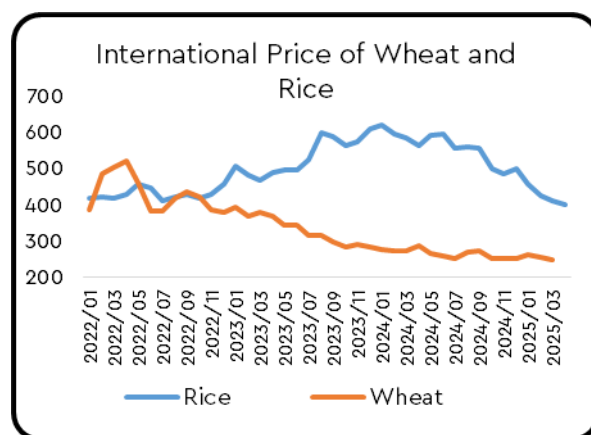

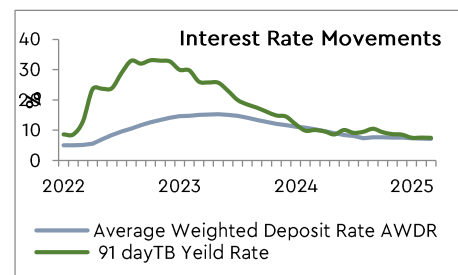
