REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.4 percent during first 9 months of 2021.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by USD 0.23 to USD 108.89 per bbl as at 18 March, 2022 from USD 108.66 per bbl as at 11 March, 2022
- CCPI increased to 15.1 percent (YoY) in February, 2022 from 14.2 percent (YoY) in January, 2022
- NCPI increased to 16.8 percent (YoY) in January from 14.0 percent (YoY) in December

- Exchange Rate remains at USD 1=Rs. 269.83
- Exports sustained at USD 1 bn in December for the seventh consecutive month in 2021, since the month of June
- Imports increased to USD 2.24 bn in December, 2021

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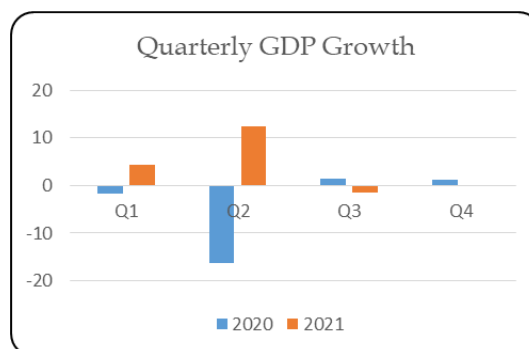

GDP contracted by 1.5 % in the Q3

The Sri Lankan economy contracted by 1.5 percent in Q3 2021 compared to the expansion of 1.3 percent in Q3 2020. The contraction was mainly driven by negative growth rates of 2.1 percent and 1.6 percent in the Industry and Services sectors, respectively and slight positive growth of 1.7 percent in the Agriculture sector, compared to the higher growth of 3.1 percent recorded in the same period of 2020.

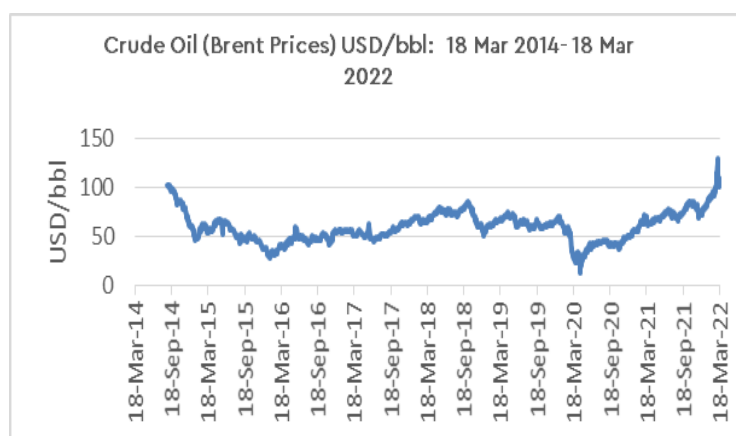
