### REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.5 percent in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2024.
  - Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 2.95 USD bbl and WTI increased by 3.82 USD bbl, respectively.
  - CCPI - Headline (2021=100) declined to -1.7 percent (YoY) in December, 2024 from -2.1 percent (YoY) in November, 2024.
  - NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) declined to -1.7 percent (YoY) in November, 2024 from -0.7 percent (YoY) in October, 2024.

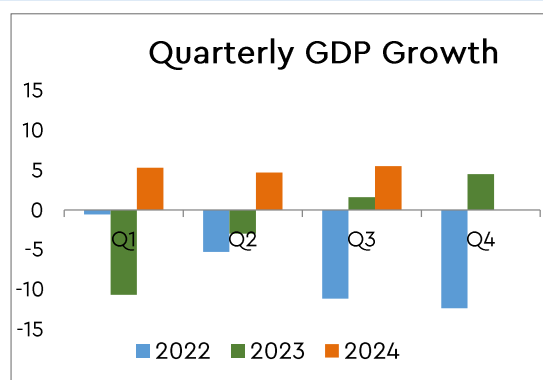

### GDP expanded by 5.5 % in 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024

In the third quarter of 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.5 percent, a notable improvement from the 1.6 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2023. This expansion was observed across all economic sectors recording a 3.0 percent, 10.8 percent, and 2.6 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

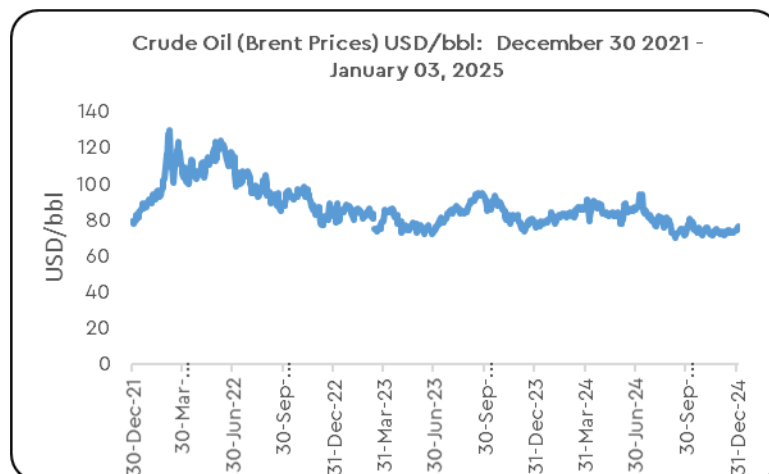
