Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Public Enterprises (COPE) have expression on the role played by the Treasury Representatives as members of the respect Boards of Public Enterprises. There have been several instances of non - compliances accountability concerns due to lack of professionalism in the management of Pu Enterprises.

Chairman also has expressed concerns that the Audit & Management committees of Pu Enterprises have not been properly constituted and operated effectively in many instances.

The Committee was of the view that, if the Treasury Representatives have played their reffectively, most of the lapses could have been avoided.

All Treasury Representatives are therefore requested to play an effective role by assisting Board in managing the Public Enterprises. Any matters of concern should be brought to notice of the Director General of the Department of Public Enterprises immediately, who turn, will bring it to the notice of relevant Deputy Secretaries to the Treasury and submit same to the COPE as requested.

I would appreciate if utmost importance is given to all financial management issues to impr Governance in Public Enterprises.

The Director General of Public Enterprises will be arranging a briefing by the 1st week December 2004 at the Auditorium of the Ministry of Finance, in this regard notified.

You are also required to assist the relevant Board is interpreting Treasury Circulars and guide them to adopt the spirit of such provisions in enterprise operations.
