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

# GDP contracted by -11.5 % in the Q1 of 2023

In the first quarter of 2023, the economy was contracted by 11.5 compared to the 0.5 percent contraction reported in the same period of 2022. This was mainly driven by the contraction of overall industrial activities by 23.4 percent in the Q1 of 2023 compared to 3.7 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2022 and 5 percent contraction of the service sector recorded in the Q1 of 2023 compared to the 1.8 percent growth recorded in the same
