The Week in Review
14 Feb- 18 Feb 2022

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.4 percent during first 9 months of 2021.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil decreased by USD 1.39 to USD 92.47 per bbl as at 18 February, 2022 from USD 91.08 per bbl as at 11 February, 2022
- CCPI increased to 14.2 percent (YoY) in January, 2022 from 12.1 percent (YoY) in December, 2021
- NCPI increased to 16.8 percent (YoY) in January from 14.0 percent (YoY) in December

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Exchange Rate remains at USD 1=Rs. 200.75
- Exports sustained at USD 1.15 bn in December the sixth consecutive month in 2021, since the month of July
- Imports increased to USD 2.24 bn in December, 2021
- Trade deficit
 - USD 1,085 mn in December
 - USD 8,136 mn in Jan-Dec
- The gross official reserves USD 2.36 bn as at the end of January
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 5.49 bn in Jan - Dec, 2021

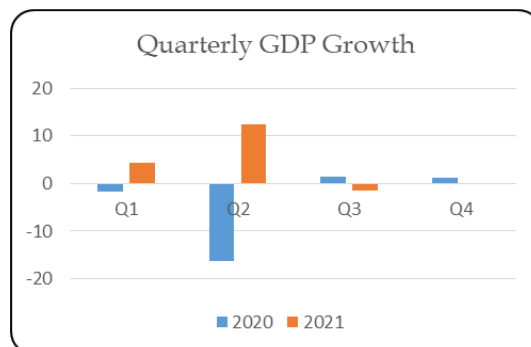

GDP contracted by 1.5 % in the Q3

The Sri Lankan economy contracted by 1.5 percent in Q3 2021 compared to the expansion of 1.3 percent in Q3 2020. The contraction was mainly driven by negative growth rates of 2.1 percent and 1.6 percent in the Industry and Services sectors, respectively and slight positive growth of 1.7 percent in the Agriculture sector, compared to the higher growth of 3.1 percent recorded in the same period of 2020.

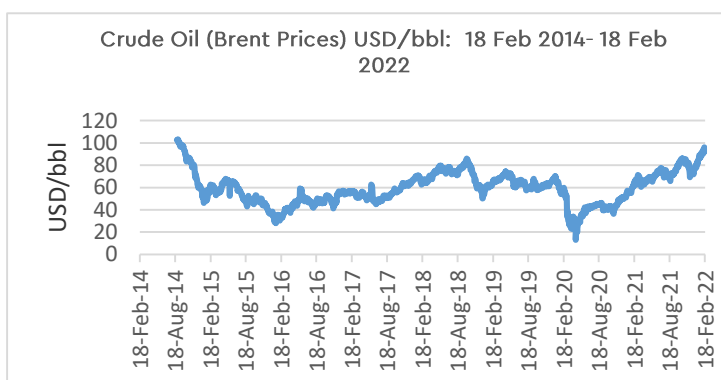
